RELIGION	Our focus for the next few weeks is on God the creator, who is present in all of creation. We will be reading and discussing the creation story. The focus for this story is: God the creator, the goodness of creation and creation as a reflection of God's love and goodness. Emphasis is then turned to the Sabbath, rest time. We will also introduce psalms of praise as a way of expressing our praise and thanks to God			
LITERACY	We will be learning to identify and write four different types of sentences: statements, questions, exclamations and commands. We will be reading the book 'ANZAC Biscuits' to learn about ANZAC Day. We will also be learning to identify adverbs, match adverbs to verbs and write sentences containing adverbs to add more detail to our writing.			
MATHS 12345 67890	number line (no regination place value to subtra	The Grade 2s will be learning to subtract one- and two-digit numbers on an empty number line (no regrouping). They will be learning to use number bonds to ten and place value to subtract multiples of ten within 100. They will also be learning to subtract two-digit numbers by partitioning into tens and ones (no regrouping).		
	The Grade 1s will be learning to make numbers 10-99 on ten-frames / with base ten blocks, express them as 'x (10s) and y (1s) more' and write the number bond. They will also be learning to use place value and part-whole knowledge to solve problems.			

	Both Grade 1s and 2s will begin to learn about Analog Time towards the end of the fortnight. You might like to practise telling the time at home.
INQUIRY	This term the students will be focusing on the Essential Question 'How do toys move?' They will focus on the following contributing questions throughout the term How did the toy move? Did the toy move the same way each time? What made the toy move? What sinks? What floats? Over the next couple of weeks the students will explore different toys and look at how and why the toy moves. They will learn about how there are pushes and pulls all around us and that science helps us to understand how things move and change shape because of pushes and pulls.
