<div>RELIGION</div> <div></div>	<p>This term the students have been learning about God the creator, who is present in all of creation. We have read and discussed the Creation story and are now looking at comparing the Creation story with Dreamtime Creation. We are looking at the similarities and differences.</p> <p>We will also be identifying key scripture stories of love and care for the environment and reflecting and explaining how people can be stewards of creation.</p>			
<div>LITERACY</div> <div></div>	<p>The students will continue to attend daily spelling sessions where they will revise previously taught sounds and irregular words. They will also learn to read, write and spell new sounds and irregular words. The grade 2s will be focusing on the sounds long /u/, long /o/ and /aw/. The grade 1s will be focusing on the sounds /ing/ and closed & open syllables.</p> <p>Over the next few weeks our Literacy will link in with Inquiry. We will be reading texts about forces and how magnets work. We will be developing our public speaking skills when presenting our findings from Inquiry sessions.</p>			
<div>MATHS</div> <div></div>	<p>The Grade 2s will be learning to measure and compare objects based on length using appropriate uniform informal units and smaller units for accuracy when necessary.</p> <p>The Grade 1s will be learning to compare directly and indirectly and order objects and events using attributes of length, communicating reasoning.</p>			


INQUIRY 	<p>The students have been learning about push and pull forces. We have investigated how paper helicopters and paper pinwheels move using these forces. Over the next few weeks, the students will be looking at magnets. We will be learning about how magnets work and the students will be making their own magnet maze.</p>
