RELIGION	TOPIC: Looking after God's Home Students have been exploring the world that God created. Students are gaining the understanding that some people believe other creation stories. They are learning about ways that they can be stewards of creation and care for the world around them, just as God has entrusted.	

LITERACY



In Literacy students will explore the book "Dear Zoo" by Rod Campbell. They will be learning about the characters, setting, problem and solution and also exploring words that rhyme. This week we will focus on handwriting and learning the sound for the letter 'z' as in 'Zoe zebra'. We will also focus on CVC words with the short A sound as in 'at, mat, sat, hat, cat, cap, sap, nap, tap, tad, mad, had, has, as'. Please use this LINK to help your child practise the LLLL Speed Sounds & Chants at home. This will show you the way that we learn the sounds of the alphabet and also reinforce your child's learning at school.

HOME DECODABLE BOOKS

Students will receive a new Decodable Book to bring home at the beginning of each week. Your child should be practising to read the same book at home every day. Before reading, revise the Speed sounds and the Heart words that can be found at the back of each book. Following this, you can:

Talk about the book



Look at the front cover and:

- Ask your child to read the title out loud, tracking their finger under each word as they read it.
- Introduce the characters your child will meet in the book
- Explore the illustrations. For example, ask: Can you point to the map?

During reading

Read and enjoy the book

- Ask your child to read out loud, tracking their finger under each word as they read
- Support your child if they are stuck by asking them to sound out and then blend the sounds together to read the word. When they have decoded the word, go back and re-read the sentence together.

After reading

Ask some of the "Questions to talk about" which can also be found at the back of each book. See if your child is able to recall some of the characters and/or key events.

MATHS

12345 67890 Students will focus on the topic of "Counting and Place Value" until the end of the Term. Students will be counting forwards and backwards from 0-20 and 20-0. They will be learning to count a collection up to 20 with 1-1 correspondence and practise reading and writing numerals to 20. They will be learning to represent numbers to 20 with concrete materials, matching numerals and collections. They will be learning to identify 'one more' and 'one less' for numbers to 20, with materials.

INQUIRY



TOPIC: 'Making Healthy and Safe Choices'

Students will be learning about how to be safe around fire. Students will participate in a "Fire Ed for Foundation" Program provided by Fire Rescue Victoria which specifically aims to educate Prep students about Fire Safety.
